The purpose of the hearing will be to review and set policy for the use of "low-powered mechanically-propelled devices" in areas open to pedestrian use.
The hearing will be held on: MONDAY, JULY 28, 2008, AT 5:30 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL ROOM AT CITY HALL AT 301 EAST WASHINGTON, NORTON, KS. Should you desire to present evidence that certain low-powered mechanically-propelled vehicles should be allowed on the City streets, to be used by physically disabled persons when sidewalks are not available, then be prepared to present evidence on July 28, 2008, at 5:30 p.m. in the Council room of City Hall at 301 East Washington, Norton, Kansas, 67654.
The proposed guidelines under the Americans with Disabilities Act make the following suggestions:
"Section 36.311 Mobility Devices.
(a) Use of wheelchairs and manually powered mobility aids. A public accommodation shall permit individuals with mobility impairments to use wheelchairs, scooters, walkers, crutches, canes, braces or similar devices in any areas open to pedestrian use.
(b) Other power-driven mobility devices. A public accommodation shall make reasonable modification in its policies, practices and procedures to permit the use of other power-driven mobility devices by individuals with disabilities unless the public accommodation can demonstrate that the use of the device is not reasonable or that its use will result in a fundamental alteration of the nature of the public accommodation's goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages or accommodations.
(c) Development of policies permitting the use of other power-driven mobility devices. A public accommodation shall establish policies to permit the use of other power-driven mobility devices by individuals with disabilities when it is reasonable to afford a public accommodation's goods, services, facilities or accommodations to an individual with a disability. Whether a modification is reasonable to allow the use of a class of power-driven mobility device by an individual with a disability in specific venues (e.g. doctor's office, parks, commercial buildings, etc.) shall be determined based on:
(1) the dimensions, weight and operating speed of the mobility device in relation to a wheelchair,
(2) the potential risk of harm to others by the operation of the mobility device;
(3) the risk of harm to the environment or natural or cultural resources or conflict with Federal land management laws and regulations; and
(4) the ability of the public accommodation to stow the mobility device when not in use, if requested by the user.
(d) Inquiry into use of mobility device. A public accommodation may ask a person using a power-driven mobility device if the mobility device is required because of the person's disability. A public accommodation shall not ask a person using a mobility device questions about the nature and extent of the person's disability."
