

A Necessity in Corporate Worship

Its chief aim is always to glorify God and worship Him."

Corporate singing enables true worshippers to enjoy the presence of the Lord. 2 Chronicles 5:13-14 says, "The trumpets and singers joined in unison, as with one voice, to give praise and thanks to the Lord. ...they raised their voices in praise to the Lord and sang: 'He is good: His love endures forever,' ...the glory of the Lord filled the temple of God."


