State fair registration goes online

HUTCHINSON—Online registration for the Kansas State Fair's competitive exhibits starts June 1. The 2009 Exhibitor's Handbook, which details competitive exhibit entry information, rules, and competition schedules, is available online and in print through the Kansas State Fair offices.

Online entries submitted before August 1 will be entered for a chance to win a 2009 Kansas State Fair Family Pack and parking permit for the day of your visit. Ten runners-up will receive a \$10 gift certificate for the 2009 Kansas State Fair. The deadline for competitive exhibit entries to be submitted online or postmarked is August 15, 2009. Entries received after that date will be accepted with a late fee.

The handbook is available at the Kansas State Fair offices located at 2000 N. Poplar St. in Hutchinson or online at kansasstatefair.com under 2009 State Fair/Competitions.

Returning competitions include the duct tape, text messaging and quilt block contests. This year's quilt block theme — horses — gives entrants a chance to show off the studs.

"The quilt block contest entrants enjoy being a part of a project that brings together Kansans and highlights themes important to our state's culture, people and history," said Debbie Anderson, competitive exhibits director. "Plus, it's great to have the opportunity to bid on the completed quilt the following year."
