

## Cross Roads

### "Prayers, Offered Up In Great Detail"

Hebrews 5:7, "During the days of Jesus' life on earth, He offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save Him from death, and He was heard because of His reverent submission."

"Prayers" (deesis) here means prayers offered in great detail for the circumstance at hand. These petitions were offered to make known to God a particular need.

Jesus did not pray generic prayers and neither should a Christian. I am convinced Christians are to be specific in their prayers as long as they are for building of God's kingdom and especially if they are for building a deeper personal relationship with Christ Himself. Please note, the Lord knows what you need before you even ask. (Matthew 6:8) However, you need to speak out from the spiritual heart what is important to you so that you may not become bitter and withdrawn from sweet fellowship with God, Christ and the Holy Spirit of Christ.

While here on this earth, Jesus prayed in loud cries, meaning an outcry of lamentations in the sense of a cry for help of one who is deeply distressed or in danger. It is like a person who is in bondage or in a trap and is calling out for help to those he may see in the distance. Rest in this truth, when you are in great distress you can cry out to God who is in heaven from the spiritual heart. God who is in heaven will hear your heart cries offered in Jesus' name. The Lord will beckon the Holy Spirit to comfort your spiritual heart and enable you know the truth that David knew, "In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From His temple He heard my voice; my cry came before Him, into His ears. (Psalm 18:6)

The writer of the book of Hebrews tells us that Jesus' prayers were "heard" (eiskakous). Meaning God was favorable to our Lord's prayers and granted Jesus' petition because being His Son, Christ lived in reverent submission.

Mature Christians, have been taught of the prayer life of Christ. They know that prayers heard by God are prayers prayed as Jesus prayed. They have a supernatural peace because they are specific in prayer.
