**ORDINANCE NO. 348**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS**  
**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:**  
**Section One.** That Section 15-225 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
**"RATES.** The rates per month for the use of water in the City shall be as follows:  
(a) The water rates for users of water on premises within the City shall be \$28.50 for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum.  
(b) The water rates for users of water on premises outside the corporate limits of the City shall be \$28.50 per month for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons over the 3,000 gallon minimum."  
**Section Two.** Ordinance No. 280 is hereby repealed.  
**Section Three.** This Ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.


