## Hansen Museum March News

The Dane G. Hansen Museum, Logan, is proud to present "Red Desert, Green Prairie, Blue Sky: Photographing the West." This fascinating exhibition unites the efforts of eight respected photographers working on three separate photography projects to mine the visual cultural landscape. Each project seeks to illuminate the beauty, tragedy and strength of a different geographic region of the western United States.

The first region, Red Desert, focuses on the unprecedented changes taking place in southern Wyoming. The lens of photographer Martin Stupich documents the loss of a staggering amount of wilderness, the Red Desert, to an industrial landscape amidst the energy boom gripping this region of the American West. The encroachment of commerce into arid, timeless wilderness accelerates each year. Within our lifetimes, the limitless horizon of the Red Desert will be broken by metal and glass industrial centers. Stupich's work testifies to the destruction of a landscape of stark beauty at the hands of ravenous human industry, and it acts as a record of that landscape's waning power.

"Red Desert, Green Prairie, Blue Sky" is a program of Exhibits USA, a national division of Mid-American Arts Alliance with The Kansas Arts Commission and The National Endowment for the Arts.

We are looking forward to the Barbara Schaffner Painting Workshop on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, April 13, 14, 15 & 16, 2011.
