ORDINANCE NUMBER 423

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR USE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 15-224 of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"RATES. The rates per month for the use of water in the City shall be as follows:

(a) For customers within the City: \$25.00 per month for the first 3,000 gallons used, and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum.

(b) For customers outside the City: \$30.00 for the first 3,000 gallons of water used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum."

SECTION TWO: Ordinances of the City of Almena, Kansas, in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and shall take effect on August 19, 2011.
