Unclaimed property tour coming to Norton

As a part of the Treasurer's "Unclaimed Property Returns" tour, Treasurer Ron Estes and staff members will be traveling throughout Kansas talking about and searching for Kansans' unclaimed property. Treasurer Estes and staff will be in Norton at the Norton County Courthouse at 105 S. Kansas on Thursday, Aug. 25 from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m.

"We encourage everyone in the area to stop by and check their name and the names of family and friends," said Estes. "In this economy everyone could use a little help and we feel it is important to be sure that these resources get back to the rightful owners. The Unclaimed Property Returns tour is a wonderful opportunity for us to connect Kansans with cash and property currently being

held by our office for free," Estes explained.

Unclaimed property includes inactive savings and checking accounts, uncashed checks, stock shares and bonds, dividend checks, insurance proceeds, mineral royalties and utility deposits.

In addition to cash, stocks and bonds, safe deposit boxes are also turned over to the State Treasurer's office. There are currently over 15,000 safe deposit box properties on file. Approximately 600 new boxes are turned over to the treasurer's office each year.

Making a claim is free and easy. There are no fees involved in searching for or claiming cash and property. To search, a last name is required and a first name is recommended.

Farm Service Agency helps farmers after crop disasters

farming operation that will be effective for the 2012 crop year, we encourage you to report those changes now so we can start the process and begin planning our work for next year. While reporting farm changes we want you to provide us with an email address for sending out electronic newsletters.

Next month wheat drilling begins in Norton County. We want all producers to know we have maps available to assist you in reporting your 2012 acreages. All you need to do is stop by the office and pick them up. We encourage you to pick up your maps and outline the acreage on them and return them to our office for certification.

Our goal is to certify your acreages by the end of December while the information is fresh in your minds and so you can also meet your crop insurance reporting deadlines. This is earlier than you are used to, however, the office staff would appreciate your cooperation in early reporting.

To be eligible for the Supplemental Disaster Assistance program, it is a requirement to have Risk Management Protection through the purchase of crop insurance on insurable crops and Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program on non-insurable crops. Risk management requires proactive planning for your farming operations.

The Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program application closing date for 2012 barley forage, canola, triticale, and wheat forage is Sept.1, 2011. The Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program service fees are \$250.00 per crop, \$750 per county, or \$1875 per producer for all counties.

Dec. 1 is the application closing date for all grasses, alfalfa, mixed forage, and oats. If you have an existing Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program policy with the Farm Service Agency, you

If you have any changes in your must report any disaster affected crops within 15 days of the known disaster.

We had a hail storm last week that affected several acres of Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program crops.

Producers need to file a notice of loss within 15 days of when the disaster occurred and if the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program crop will not be harvested due to a disaster you need to request an appraisal of the crop.

As a reminder, all Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program producers must submit their production from Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program crops. Keep a detailed daily log in a notebook or day-planner, to keep track of the date you swath and bale and the number of bales per cutting.

All production records must be reliable and verifiable. A measurement service is the recommended means to document production records.

With the recent hail storm in Norton County, it has come to our attention of several producers who have lost their feed crop and may be in need of acquiring some hay. We have received phone calls asking if there is a listing anywhere of producers with extra hay. If you have access to the internet, the Farm Service Agency has a tool to help producers who are needing hay connect with those who have extra hay available.

What you need to do is Google "Hay Net" and click on the HAY NET link that has the Farm Service Agency in the story line. This link will take you to the web site that explains how hay net works.

By creating an account, you can post information about hay you have available or you can post your needs for hay. If you just want to find hay you do not have to create an account, you can just go in and view. We really need to get producers to use this tool and help each other get the word out.

The Norton Farm Service Agency is offering commodity loans for your 2011 wheat. The loan rate on Wheat for Norton County is \$2.65/bu. The interest rate is 1.125percent for loans disbursed in August. Loans may be requested on warehouse stored grain or farm stored grain.
