

evening because violence, especially in the dark of night, is an ever-present danger.
 "I was the only white guy around," Rowh said. "It would not have been safe for me to walk around at night, especially alone."
 Though the people of Kenya are very poor, Rowh explained that the economy is supported primarily by the county's tourism industry. Wildlife refuges are numerous throughout Kenya, which draw tourists for safaris and excursions. The primary language of the country is Swahili, but the educated people of the country are also fluent in

English. During his evenings of preaching, though, a translator was used to make sure the message reached everyone listening.
 Rowh got involved in missions work more than a decade ago and, soon after returning from his latest trip, he is already making plans to visit again next year. His next trip will include a trip to Kenya, along with visits to Uganda and Tanzania, where he has been invited to preach.
