And, he was even an assistant grade school wrestling coach for four years under coach Jake Durham in the mid-70s.

peting in football, basketball, track and baseball.

"Retiring from the Norton School System did not stop his love of sports and his commitment to the Youth Sports in Norton.

"Before he retired from the school district, he joined the Norton Recreation Commission as, what else but the Activity Director and he is still in this position today. He is still involved in many youth sports camps and programs in Norton. This includes baseball, softball, basketball, youth football, soccer, track and I am sure others. One of Steve's many contributions includes the supervision and work on the renovation of the Blue Jay Field, often referred to as 'Schrum Field.'
