A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTIES
TO BE UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS
AND ORDERING THEIR REPAIR OR REMOVAL****WHEREAS**, Ordinance #260, provides a procedure for ordering the repair or
removal of dangerous structures; and**WHEREAS**, the enforcing officer has filed a statement with the governing
body pursuant to Ordinance #260 declaring certain structures to be unsafe or
dangerous; and,**WHEREAS**, on February 6, 2012, the Norcatcur City Council met and held a
hearing after proper notice concerning making a determination of whether or not
such structures were unsafe or dangerous.NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
CITY OF NORCATCUR, KANSAS, that:**Section 1:** After hearing testimony from Jan Katz Ackerman, Code Enforcement
Officer, the council finds that the property at 112 N. Dexter is unsafe and dangerous
and orders the owner to repair or remove the structure no later than April 30,
2012. If, by April 30, 2012, the property is not repaired or moved, the city will
proceed to remove the property.**Section 2:** This resolution shall be published in the official city newspaper
one time, and the enforcing officer shall mail by certified, restricted delivery mail,
marked "deliver to addressee only a copy of this resolution to each such owner,
agent, lienholder or occupant of each of the structures described above.
