

# Norton Junior High holds invitational

Cold, wind and overcast skies was the backdrop for the Norton Junior High Invitational Track Meet held at Travis Field on Tuesday. Despite the inhospitable weather, a large crowd attended the 10-team invitational meet.

The Norton 8th grade girls team acquitted themselves well, finishing in second place with 86 points behind first place Colby Middle School with 157 points. Northern Valley's girls finished in the middle of the pack, taking fifth place with 52 points and Logan's girls finished in seventh with 26 points.

For Norton's eighth grade girls' Cayanna Campbell placed third in the 200 meter dash in a time of 30.33 and then she placed fifth in the 400 meter dash with a time of 1:11.73. Peyton Renner took fourth in the 800 meter run in 3:02.81. Molly Maddy ran the 1600 meter run in 6:42.18 for a fourth place finish. Maddy also took first in the 3200 meter run in 14:30.43 followed by Lauren Mordecai coming in third with a time of 15:14.17.

The eighth grade 4X100 meter relay team of Hailey Branek, Morgan Griffey, Alexis Hartwell and Audrey Morel took fifth in a time of 1:07.57

In the 4X200 meter relay the Norton team of Casey Ambrosier, Shelby Mulford, Hanna Brooks and Cayanna Campbell placed second in 2:08.31.

The foursome of Cayanna Campbell, Raenee Patterson, Shelby Mulford and Hanna Brooks took third in the 4X400 meter relay with a time of 5:12.00

Hanna Brooks takes second in the high jump with four feet two inches. Then she placed fifth in the triple jump with 27-00.05 followed by Casey Ambrosier

in third with 26-02.00.

Molly Maddy took first in the pole vault, lifting herself seven feet followed by Peyton Renner in fourth with a height of six feet. Nickala O'Hare came in sixth with a six foot height as well.

Lexi Voss took second in the shot put with a throw of 31-08.00 and then took sixth in the discus throw with a distance of 66 feet ten inches. Lastly, she placed fourth in the weight throw with a throw of 126-04.00.

Scott City Middle School dominated the 8th grade boys competition with 137 points and a first place finish. Norton's boys had a very respectable showing, finishing in fourth place with 57 points. Northern Valley finished in seventh with 21.5 points and Logan followed in eighth place with 16 points.

The Norton's eighth grade boys' Gavin Lively placed third in the 200 meter dash in 26.53 then he took third in the 400 meter dash in a time of 1:01.58

Brendon Frack got sixth in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:40.12 and then he took second with a time of 12:00.59 in the 3200 meter run. Riley Hager placed second in the 1600 meter run in 5:46.00 followed by Mike Kasson in fifth in 5:48.12.

Cameron Heikes took second place in the 100 meter hurdles in 18.03.

The 4X200 meter relay team of Cameron Heikes, Cody Campbell, Ward Hays and Chandler Summer placed third in a time of 2:04.50 and the 4X400 meter relay team of Quinton Porter, Riley Hager, Weston Erbert and Gavin Lively placed fourth in 4:36.34.

Gavin Lively then finished his day off by winning second place in the high jump with a height of 4 feet ten inches.

The Norton 7th grade girls

team finished in eighth place with 36 points, 51 points behind first place winner Colby Middle School. Logan's girls had an excellent meet finishing in second place with 70 points. Northern Valley's girls finished in ninth with 21 points.

For the Norton seventh grade girls, Caitlyn placed second in the 400 meter dash in a time of 1:10.55 and then she won the 100 yard dash in 19.46.

The 4X200 meter relay team of Baylee Miller, Kendra Cadwalader, Jena Risewich and Caitlyn Cox placed sixth with a time of 2:20.46.

Two of Norton's pole vaulters placed. Baylee Miller took second with 5:06.00 followed by Miah Melvin in third with a height of 5 feet even.

Caitlyn Cox took sixth in the long jump with a distance of 11-05.00 and Baylee Miller placed fifth in the triple jump with a distance of 23-08.50.

Scott City's 7th grade boys, like the 8th grade boys, dominated the competition finishing in first place with 109.5 points.

Norton's boys had a strong showing with 62.5 points along with a third place finish. Northern Valley finished in ninth place with 14 points and Logan managed only eight points, finishing in tenth place.

The Norton seventh grade boy placed well in the 1600 meter run with Tyus Henson taking first in 5:46.90 followed by Nate Hartwell in third in 5:52.38.

Jacob Green placed third in the 200 meter dash in 29.46 and first in the shot put with a throw of 39-11.75.

Tyus Henson took first in the 100 yard hurdles in 18:24 and second in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:31.97.

The 4X200 meter relay team of Landon Porter, Trenton Wright, Kade Unterseher and

Jacob Green placed sixth in 2:14.41.

Tyus Henson placed third in the high jump with a height of 4 feet six inches followed by Landon Porter in fifth at four feet two inches.

Kade Unterseher added points to Norton's score when he placed fourth in the pole vault with a height of six feet six inches.
