Tickets go on sale April 30 for the first ever Pro Bull Riders event in Phillipsburg.

The PBR, which is well known for its high energy, dynamic bull riding events, will be held June 2 at the rodeo grounds.

About 40 bull riders are expected in town to compete for \$10,000 in prize money.

Fans can purchase their tickets beginning April 30 at Heritage Insurance in Phillipsburg.

Anticipation for the event is growing.

"People are excited for the PBR to come to town," said Rod Innes, rodeo chairman. "We've put together a good show, from a good bull contractor to clowns, because we know fans appreciate not only good rodeo action but good entertainment."

Jimmy Crowthers of New Frontier Rodeo, Gypsum, will bring bucking bulls to the event, and rodeo clown and barrel man Justin Rumpf, Ponca City, Okla., will entertain. Announcer is Troy Goodridge, Ft. Scott, and bullfighters

are Mark Peters and Danny Munsell. A dance featuring Mark Nebel will be held after the PBR on June 2 at the rodeo grounds.

Tickets for the PBR are \$18 for general admission and \$20 for reserved seating. They are available at Heritage Insurance in Phillipsburg and can be purchased over the phone at 785-543-2448.

The PBR is held in conjunction with the Riverless Festival, which runs June 2-3 and features an arts and crafts fair/flea market, music on the square, 2-mile run/walk, men's softball tournament, state sanctioned kids pedal pushers event, open horse show, games and vendors.

Phillipsburg fans know good bull riding when they see it," said Innes. "This PBR will be as good as the bull riding they see on TV."

Midwest Transplant Network's Donor Memorial Quilt is dedicated to the memory of all those who have given gifts of life through organ, tissue or eye donation. Since its beginning in the year 2000 hundreds of families have chosen to honor their loved ones by creating a quilt square in his/her memory.

Many families choose to adorn their loved one's quilt square with special details such as a photograph, poem, quote or symbol of the donor's life. The Donor Memorial Quilt is a work

in progress. There is no deadline, and it is never finished, as we know there will always be other families who face the death of a loved one and make the decision to donate.

The Local Quilting Class Exhibit will feature the quilts created in quilting classes offered through the Continuing Education Program at the Dane G. Hansen Museum. 
