A RESOLUTION FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING ON PUBLIC OFFICER'S REPORT FINDING THE PREMISES OF LESLIE R. AND SALLY L. ELLIS, 335 SOUTH THIRD STREET, LENORA, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS, UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION, DANGEROUS AND UNSAFE

SECTION TWO: That this resolution shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper and that notice by certified mail be sent to each owner, agent, lienholder and occupant of the premises.

ORDINANCE NO. 1622

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE NORTH HALF OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 2, GOLF'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF NORTON, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: That the governing body of the City of Norton, Kansas, deems it necessary and expedient to vacate all of the north half of the alley in Block 2, Golf's Addition to the City of Norton, Norton County, Kansas, all as contemplated by K.S.A. 14-423, and that the same should be and is hereby vacated.

Section 2: That the land vacated hereby shall revert to the owner of the real estate thereto adjacent on each side of said alley in proportion to the frontage of such real estate.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall become effective thirty days after publication thereof, unless one or more interested parties shall file a written protest before the expiration of said thirty 30 days.

Section 4: That upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the Norton County Clerk and with the Register of Deeds of Norton County, Kansas

Re: Gore Oil Company Application for a permit to authorize the enhanced recovery of saltwater into the Noone #9 SWD, located in Norton County, Kansas.

To: All Oil and Gas Producers, Unleased Mineral Interest Owners, Landowners, and all persons whomsoever concerned.

You and each of you, are hereby notified that Gore Oil Company has filed an Application to commence the injection of saltwater into the Cedar Hills formation at the Noone #9, located 125' FNL & 430' FWL of Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 21 West, Norton County, Kansas, with a maximum operating pressure on vacuum and a maximum injection rate of 1,000 barrels per day.

Any persons who object or protest this application shall be required to file their objections or protests with the Conservation Division of the State Corporation Commission of the State of Kansas within fifteen (15) days from the date of this publication. These protests shall be filed pursuant to Commission regulations and must state specific reasons why the grant of the application may cause waste, violate correlative rights or pollute the natural resources of the State of Kansas.
