#### ORDINANCE NO. 355

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS, ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES, WORK-SITE UTILITY VEHICLES AND MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS ON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

#### SECTION ONE. OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS.

- (a) Golf carts may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the City by a driver of at least 18 years of age.
- (b) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three (3) wheels in contact with the ground, and an unladen weight of not more than 1,800 pounds, is designed to be and is operated at not more than 25 miles per hour and is designed to carry not more than four (4) persons including the driver.
- (c) No golf cart shall be operated on any public highway, street, road or alley between sunset and sunrise, unless equipped with lights as required for motorcycles.
- (d) Every person operating a golf cart on the streets, roads and alleys of the City shall be subject to all the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.
- (e) A person operating a golf cart shall ride only on the permanent and regular seat attached thereto, and such operator shall not carry any other person, nor shall any other person ride on golf cart, unless such golf cart is designed to carry more than one (1) person, in which event, a passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular seat, if designed for two (2) persons, or upon another seat firmly attached to the golf cart at the rear or side of the operator.
- (f) No person shall operate a golf cart at a speed greater than the posted limit, or 25 miles per hour, whichever is less.
- (g) No operator shall carry any person, nor shall any person ride in a position that will interfere with the operation or control of the golf cart or the view of the operator.
- (h) No person riding upon a golf cart shall attach himself or herself or the golf cart to any other vehicle on the roadway.

#### SECTION TWO. OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

- (a) All-terrain vehicles (ATV) may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the City by a driver of at least 18 years of age.
- (b) "All-terrain vehicle" (ATV) means any motorized non-highway vehicle 48" or less in width, having a dry weight of 1,000 pounds or less, traveling on three (3) or more low-pressure tires, and having a seat being straddled by the operator. As used in this subsection, "low-pressure tire" means any pneumatic tire six inches (6") or more in width, designed for use on wheels with rim diameter of 12" or less, and utilizing an operating pressure of 10 pounds per square inch or less as recommended by the vehicle manufacturer.
- (c) No ATV shall be operated on any public highway, street, road or alley between sunset and sunrise, unless equipped with lights as required for motorcycles.
- (d) No ATV shall be operated on any public highway, street, road or alley unless such vehicle shall comply with the equipment requirements under the provisions of Article 17, Chapter 8, of the Kansas Statutes Annotated.
- (e) Every person operating an ATV on the streets, roads and alleys of the City shall be subject to all the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.
- (f) A person operating an ATV shall ride only on the permanent and regular seat attached thereto, and such operator shall not carry any other person, nor shall any other person ride on ATV, unless such ATV is designed to carry more than one (1) person, in which event, a passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular seat, if designed for two (2) persons, or upon another seat firmly attached to the ATV at the rear or side of the operator.
- (g) A person shall ride upon an ATV only while sitting astride the seat, facing forward, and with one (1) leg on each side of the ATV.
- (h) No person shall operate an ATV while carrying any package, bundle or other article which prevents such person from keeping both hands on the handlebars.
- (i) No operator shall carry any person, nor shall any person ride in a position that will interfere with the operation or control of the ATV or the view of the operator.
- (j) No person riding upon an ATV shall attach himself or herself or the ATV to any other vehicle on the roadway.

#### SECTION THREE. OPERATION OF WORK-SITE UTILITY VEHICLES AND MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS.

- (a) Work-site utility vehicles and micro utility trucks may be operated upon the public highways, streets, road and alleys within the corporate limits of the City.
- (b) "Work-site Utility Vehicle" means any motor vehicle that is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of not more than 135 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of more than 800 pounds and is equipped with four (4) or more low pressure tires, a steering wheel and bench or bucket type seating allowing at least two (2) people to sit side-by-side, and may be equipped with a bed or cargo box for hauling materials.
- (c) "Micro Utility Truck" means any motor vehicle, which is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of not more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. Micro utility truck does not include a work-site utility vehicle.
- (d) No work-site utility vehicle or micro utility truck shall be operated on any public highway, street, road or alley unless such vehicle shall comply with the equipment requirements under the provisions of Article 17, Chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated.
- (e) Every person operating a work-site utility vehicle or micro utility truck on the public highways, streets, roads and alleys of the City shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.

**SECTION FOUR. SAME; PENALTIES.** The violation of any provision of Section One, Two and Three shall be deemed an ordinance traffic infraction. Upon an entry of the plea of guilty or no contest or upon being convicted of such violation, the penalty imposed shall be in accordance with Section 201 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance, 2011 Edition, as amended, or such other similar provision as the City may then have in effect.

**SECTION FIVE. SAME; VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIRED; AGE OF OPERATOR; PENALTY.** No person shall operate a golf cart, all-terrain vehicle, work-site utility vehicle or micro utility truck on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the City, unless such person has a valid driver's license, and is at least 18 years of age. Violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

**SECTION SIX. PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
