The Right to Bear Arms: The 2nd Amendment Substantiated by Personal Testimonies

The intruder made his way through the house, and as he was opening the door of the closet, the young girl shot him through the closet door. "On Sunday, December 16, 2012, two days after the CT shooting, a man went to a restaurant in San Antonio to kill his ex-girlfriend. After he shot her, most of the people in the restaurant fled next door to a theater. The gunman followed them and entered the theater

so he could shoot more people. He started shooting and people in the theater started running and screaming. It's like the Aurora, CO theater story plus a restaurant! However, there was an off duty county deputy at the theater. She pulled out her gun and shot the man 4 times before he had a chance to kill anyone. This true story makes the point,

LOGANVILLE, Ga. - "A woman hiding in her attic with children shot an intruder multiple times before fleeing to safety. The incident happened at a home on Henderson Ridge Lane in Loganville around 1:00 p.m. The woman was working in an upstairs office when she spotted a strange man outside a window, according to Walton County Sheriff Joe Chapman. He said she took her 9-year-old twins to a crawlspace before the man broke in using a crowbar. 'The perpetrator opens that door. Of course, at that time he's staring at her, her two children and a .38 revolver,' Chapman told Channel 2's Kerry Kavanaugh... 'My wife is a hero. She protected her kids. She did what she was supposed to do as responsible, prepared gun owner,' Donnie Herman said. 'Her life is saved, and her kids' life is saved, and that's all I'd like to say,' Herman said."
