Work begins on K-9 in Norton

Starting Tuesday May 28, and continuing for approximately three weeks, a survey team from the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will start surveying along K-9 Highway in Norton County.

The survey work will take place 0.5-mile east of the K-9/K-173 junction (Densmore). Specifically, the survey will focus on the bridge located over Big Timber Creek.

The survey is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement of the Big Timber Creek Bridge.

Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor. When it becomes necessary for crew members to enter private property, they will first obtain permission from the landowner or tenant.
