

Fees will be negotiated for projects as federal funds become available. Prospective consultants are advised that applied overhead rates must be in accordance with the cost principals established within Federal Regulation 48 CFR Part 31, Contract Cost Principles and Procedures. The successful firm will be required to submit a copy of their current overhead rate audit certification.

Faster times for Huskies in second meet

In contrast to the sweltering heat of the season opening race in Norton last week, cloudy skies and cooler air greeted the Northern Valley Cross Country team at the Rooks County Golf Course for their second race of the season. All five runners responded with season best times, and three recorded personal bests against a deep field of competition.

Thirty varsity girls contended for medals in the first race of the day and Northern Valley's sophomore Brooke Baird ran with the fastest of them to a 6th place medal and a season best time of 18:19. Classmate Allison Keith lowered her time from last week's season opener by 3 minutes to 23:12 to place 25th.

Junior Macy Kasson placed 19th in a strong field of over 40 varsity runners to medal for the second week in a row. Her time of 20:16 not only was over one minute faster than his Norton time, but was 12 seconds faster than his personal best from last year. Sophomore Camden Cox lowered his personal best time by 17 seconds to finish 34th. It was his second PR in as many races.

Running only his second race sophomore Matt Florence lowered his PR by one minute with a time of 26:32 to finish 15th in the Junior Varsity race.

Fast times for the meet were Leslie Van Loenen of Hill City in 16:45 and Wyatt Ratzlaff of Phillipsburg, with a time of 17:53.
