 Section 324 of the Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act (EPCRA), also known as the SARA Title III (Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, PL99-499), requires public notice at least once annually informing the public of the means to access information about extremely hazardous substances that are manufactured, stored, and used within their community. Follow-up emergency notices may subsequently be issued.  Annual Tier II reports have been received, catalogued, and distributed to the LEPC Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary/Treasurer, Fire Departments (Almena, Norton City, Norton Rural, Lenora, and NCF), and Local Civil Defense Agencies (City Police, County Sheriff, and NCF). Any person with questions should contact the LEPC Information Coordinator.
 Annual review of the Norton County Hazard Analysis (HA) and Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) was completed in August 2013. Any person wishing to view the HA and HMP should contact the LEPC Information Coordinator.
