

Here's How It Works:
Sudoku puzzles are formatted as a 9x9 grid, broken down into nine 3x3 boxes. To solve a sudoku, the numbers 1 through 9 must fill each row, column and box. Each number can appear only once in each row, column and box. You can figure out the order in which the numbers will appear by using the numeric clues already provided in the boxes. The more numbers you name, the easier it gets to solve the puzzle!

Zoning changes in your neighborhood. A proposal to increase your property taxes. Information on how public officials are spending your tax dollars. It is the government's responsibility to notify you of public information, and your local newspaper is the most accessible place to find it.
