ORDINANCE NO. 1648
AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A TWO-WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT WEST CRANE STREET AND KENNEDY DRIVE WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON AND PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. STOP INTERSECTION. In accordance with the provisions of Section 59 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, the following intersection is hereby designated as a two-way stop intersection and when signs are erected at the entrances as stated, the drivers of vehicles shall stop, as provided by said Section 59, before entering the intersection:
The intersection of West Crane and Kennedy Drive, stopping the east and west bound traffic on West Crane Street, al in the City of Norton, Kansas.
Section 2. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fines for violation of the stop intersection provisions of this ordinance are those prescribed for the Standard Traffic Ordinance of Norton.
Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, and the erection of the stop signs.
PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY of the City of Norton, Kansas, this 6th day of November, 2013.
