On Saturday, April 12, 2014 the AYSO Region 1365 Youth Soccer Organization played their 3rd week of soccer.

The results for Saturday's games were as follows:

Division U6 – Team Meyer, also known as White Fox 4 came up against Team Collins or otherwise known as the Raiders, who took this match by a score of 8-1. The one goal for White Fox 4 came off the foot of #5 - Sproul. Scoring for the Raiders were #5 Collins with 3, #2 Brooks had 3, and #6 Sattler along with #3 Abel each had 1.

In the 110 high hurdles Clint Cole placed 4th with a time of 18.83 seconds.

In the 100m Jordan Baird placed 4th with a time of 11.95 seconds.

In the 200m Jordan Baird placed 3rd with a time of 24.12 seconds and Phillip Bryant placed 6th with a time of 24.96 seconds.

In the 300 intermediate hurdles Clint Cole placed 6th with a time of 48.25 seconds.

In the 400m Philip Rupp placed 4th with a time of 57.28 seconds.

In the 1600m Brant Cox placed 4th with a time of 5:19.3. In the 4X100 relay Phillip Bryant, Hunter Chandler, Philip Rupp, Jordan Baird placed 3rd with a time of 46.54 seconds.

In the 4X400 relay Anderson, Hunter Chandler, Brant Cox and Matt Stutsman placed 5th with a time of 3:58.93.

In the high jump Hunter Chandler placed 3rd with a

height of 5'10" and Clint Cole placed 6th with a height of 5'6".

In the long jump Jordan Baird placed 1st with 19'4.75" and Phillip Bryant placed 4th with 18'10".

In pole vault Clint Cole placed 1st with 12'0".

In shot put Ian Vincent placed 6th with a distance of 41'6.25".

The weather did not cooperate as well for this meet. There was quite a little wind but we still had some good performances.

In the 300m intermediate hurdles Ian Vincent came through with another personal record in the shot put. I felt like Jordan Baird had good races in both the 100m and 200m. Our 400m relay team set another personal record. Jordan and Phillip Bryant both had good jumps into the wind in the long jump. Clint Cole came up big in the pole vault for us.

In the 1600m, Brant Cox bettered his time from the first meet. I was pleased with our 2nd place finish in the team standings, as there were 15 teams in attendance.

In javelin Kortney Cunningham placed 3rd with a distance of 98'10" and Sarah Baird place 5th with a distance of 86'1".

In shot put Shayna Vincent placed 3rd with a distance of 30'2.5".

Our girls also had a good meet. They finished 3rd out of 16 schools. Kortney Cunningham was able to medal in all four of her events again this week. She had a very good jump in the triple jump. Brooke Baird ran her best time of the season in the 100m hurdles. Shayna Vincent medaled once again in the shot put. I was especially happy to see Sarah Baird place

in the javelin in a meet of this size. This week we host the Husky Invitational in Logan on Monday and travel to Osborne on Friday for the Kaser Relays.


