Devil wrestlers win Dundy County Tournament

The Decatur Community High wrestlers won the Dundy County Invitational Tournament in Nebraska on Saturday.

"This was a varsity tournament for which we were scheduled to take our junior varsity," Coach Joe Dreher said, "but, since we had a double dual canceled because of weather, we sent our younger var-

sity wrestlers also." Oberlin won the tournament with 149.5 points. Holyoke, Colo., was second with 143.5, followed by Southwest High, 128; Wauneta-Palisade, 108.5; Stratton, 105.5; Dundy County, 74; Atwood, 54; Revere, 26; Wray, Colo., 18; Hitchcock County, 18; Hershey, 13; and unattached wrestlers, 11.

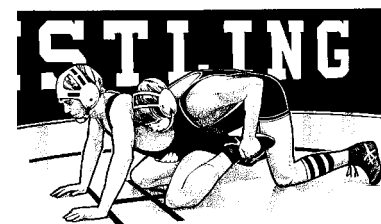
