*The Topeka Capitol-Journal* gave Fortin honorable mention in its list of all-state players.

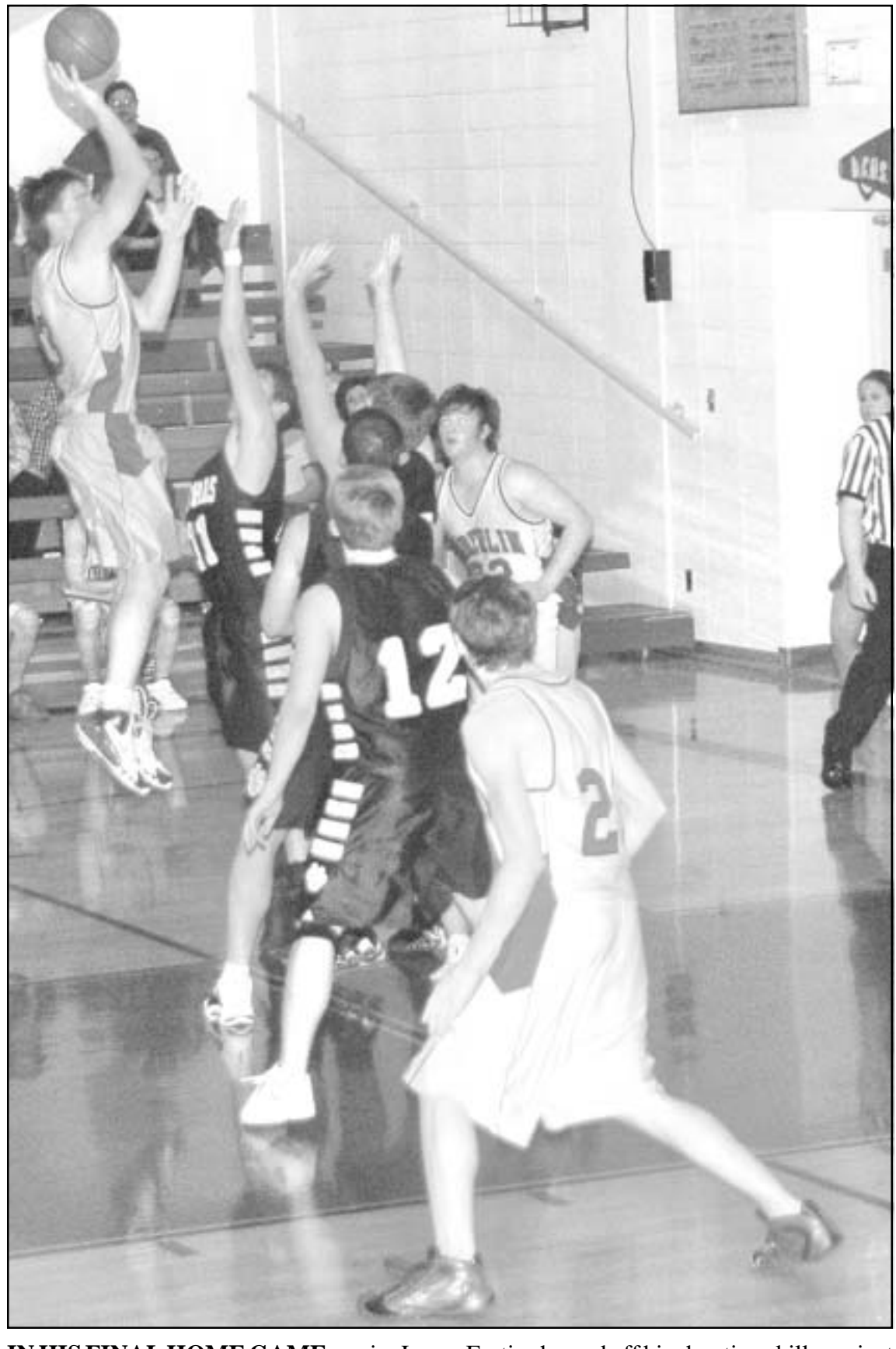

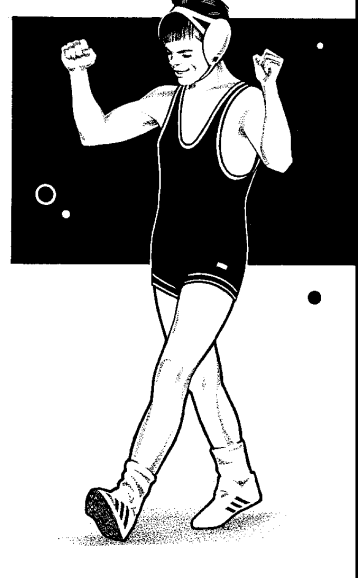
## Kid Wrestlers attend state meet
