Environmental assessment available

Notice of the Availability of an Environmental Assessment

The USDA-Rural Utilities Service has received an application for financial assistance from the City of Oberlin. As required by the National Environmental Policy Act, the Rural Utilities Service has prepared an Environmental Assessment that evaluated the potential environmental effects and consequences of the proposed project. This notice announces the availability of the Environmental Assessment for public review and comment.

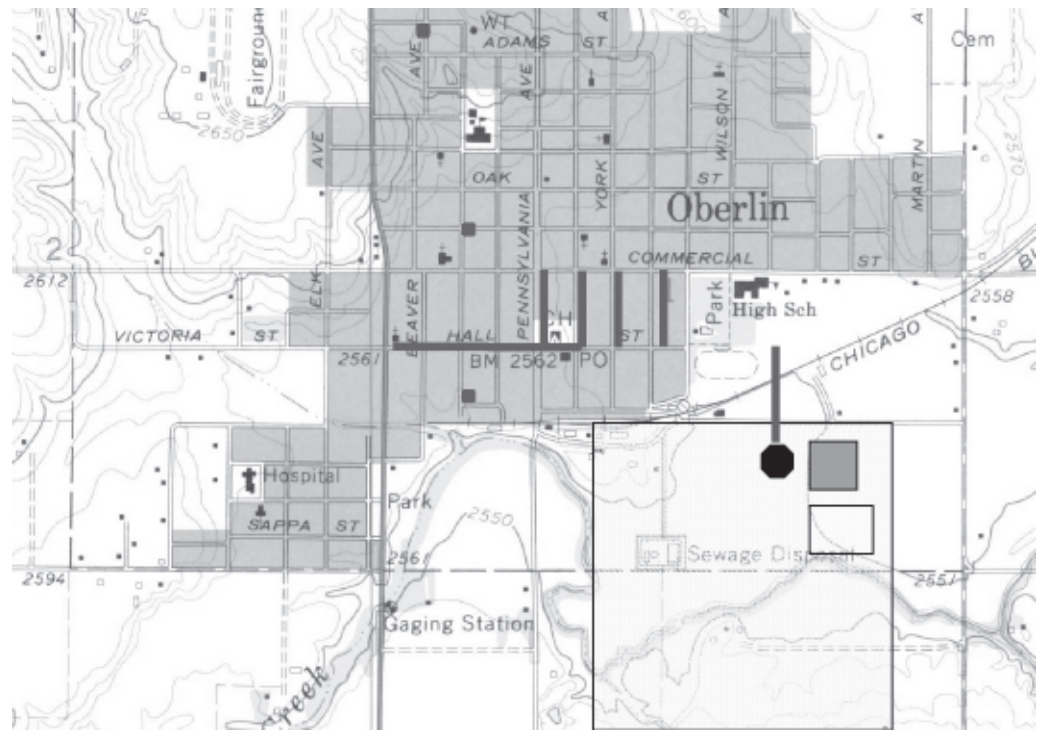
The proposed improvements, which consists of the construction of a new water treatment facility, sludge lagoon, water well and water distribution improvements, will

conform to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) drinking water regulations, as well as requirements for ground water disinfections and disposal of treatment residuals. This project includes the following components, approximately 3,800 LF of new water transmission piping to bring the water from the City's existing wells to a single point for treatment and connect to the existing distribution system, a new water treatment facility to address uranium compliance, an approximate 3,200 SF water treatment building to house the treatment equipment and related chemical feed systems, pumps, valves, piping and controls, a new backwash waste lagoon to process

clarifier and filter backwash waste from the new water treatment facility. The proposed project will convert floodplain and wetland areas. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public of this proposed conversion and request comments concerning the proposed project.

The City has made preliminary application to KDHE for the Loan, the proceeds of which will be used by the City for finance certain modifications and improvements (the "Project") to the City's water supply and distribution system (the "System"), to pay Loan origination costs and interest during construction of the Project. Further information regarding the nature and scope of the Project, the source of revenues pledged to secure the Loan, the City's financial information, the City's water conservation plan and environmental impact information, the proposed Loan documents and the schedule of rates proposed by the Governing Body to enable the City to meet its financial obligations for the Loan are available for public inspection and copying at any time during normal business hours at the address set forth below.

The Governing Body will not adopt a resolution authorizing the completion of the Loan application and the execution and delivery of the Loan documents until after the conclusion of the public hearing described in this Notice.
