Helen Elizabeth Fairbanks, 93, a graduate of Herndon High School, died Sept. 11, 2007, at Good Samaritan Hospital in Kearney, Neb.

She was born Aug. 16, 1914, near Herndon, the daughter of Paul and Susanna (Leitner) Goltl. After graduating at Herndon, she attended Hastings Business College. After graduating from Hastings Business College in 1934, she worked for the Nebraska State Legislature in Lincoln for two years, then returned to Hastings, Neb., to work at Dominy Insurance Company for six years. She and her husband founded Fairbanks International in Shelton in 1950, and she was secretary until they retired in 1975. They moved to Kearney in 1999 and her husband died on Jan. 8, 2004.
