## Teen director gives presentation to Rotary

Pastor Doug Mason spoke about the Teens for Christ program in Oberlin at the Oberlin Rotary Club meeting at The Gateway last Tuesday. He was introduced by Gary Fredrickson, program chair for the day.

Mr. Mason said that he began three years ago with 11 students, and the group has grown to 19. The idea of the group is to reach into the lives of teens in a spiritual way, he said.

"TFC provides an environment especially suited for a teen to grow spiritually," he said. "At TFC meetings, a child can be one's own self and know they are loved, can have fun and enjoy interacting with their peers, and most important, examine their own spiritual growth."

"TFC reaches into the lives of

teens through Connection meetings, which happen in communities within a 150-mile radius of Phillipsburg, where it all began."

A video presentation showed students clearing land for a building, roofing buildings and making other repairs on mission trips, which have taken them to places from Arkansas to Alaska. Mr. Mason said the group meets from 6 to 8 p.m. every Sunday downtown.

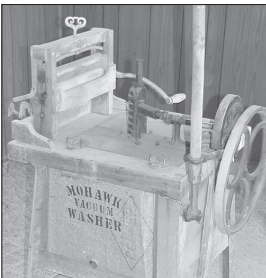

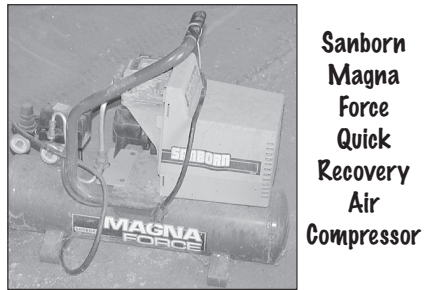

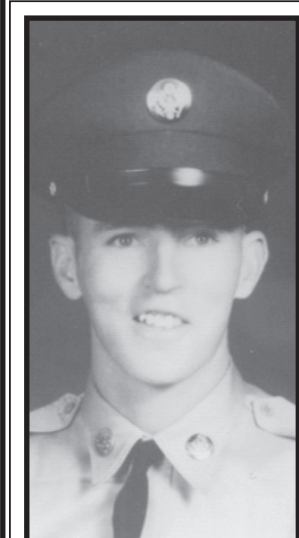
