## Senior signs to play

Decatur Community High senior Toby Peters will be heading to Garden City this fall to attend college and play football.

Peters, the son of Randy and Lynda Peters, signed a letter of intent with the college earlier this year. He will join teammate Wiley Farr on the Broncbusters' football roster this fall.

During his senior year, Peters played tight end and linebacker for the Red Devils. He carried the ball nine times for 73 yards and two touchdowns, completed two out of three passes for 55 yards and had 34 catches for 730 yards and six touchdowns. His longest was for 78 yards.

On defense, he had 37 tackles, 87 assists, five interceptions for 66 yards, a blocked pass and a fumble recovery.

This year, Peters is president of both the weight club and the D-Club. He was in the school play last year.

While he's not sure what his major will be, Peters said he hopes to get his general undergraduate courses taken at Garden City and then perhaps go on to K-State to finish a bachelor's degree.

He said that on a recruiting trip to Garden City, the coaches and staff were great and the college seems a good fit for him. In addition, he said, there are several students he knows there, and it's only two hours from home.

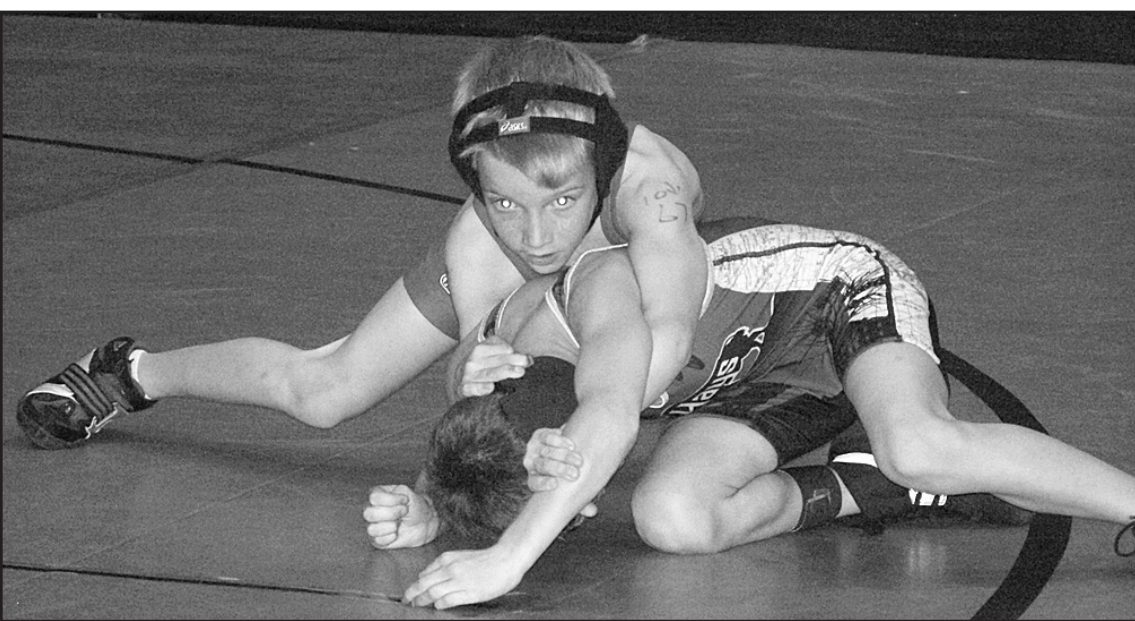
