## Girls win first at Hoxie meet

The Decatur Community High girls team took first at the Hoxie Invitational track meet on Friday while the boys came in second.

Oberlin's girls had 144 points to win the meet, followed by Hoxie with 119; Hill City, 96; St. Francis, 78; Golden Plains, 35; Cheylin, 30; and Palco, 15.

The Hill City boys won the meet with 123 points, followed by Oberlin, 89; Palco, 84; St. Francis, 67; Hoxie, 60; Cheylin, 58; and Rexford, 42.

Several Oberlin athletes had to leave early because they were taking part in the school play, which had its first performance Friday night.
