Girls take second

The Decatur Community High girls track team was edged out of first place by the Oakley women last Tuesday in St. Francis, but not by much.

Oakley won the meet with 103 points followed by Oberlin 101.5; Wray, Colo., 91; Tribune 63.5; Hoxie 57; Atwood 27; Burlington, Colo. 26; Weskan 24.5; St. Francis 23; Sharon Springs 21; Cheylin 10; Brewster 5; and Triplains 1.5.

The Oberlin girls shined in the 100-meter dash and shot put, taking first and second in both. The Oberlin women also took first in the pole vault, javelin and 4x100-meter relay.

Boys finish sixth at St. Francis meet

The Decatur Community High boys came in sixth at the St. Francis Invitational last Tuesday, and the 4x800-meter relay team brought back a gold medal.

Burlington, Colo., won the meet with 96 points, followed by the home team, St. Francis, with 86; Oakley, 81; Wray, Colo., 75; Tribune, 74; Oberlin, 39.75; Hoxie, 31; Atwood, 29.5; Brewster, 14; Sharon Springs, 13; Triplains, 9.75; Weskan, 6; and Cheylin, 3.

While some schools record all times and distances, officials at St. Francis only recorded the top six finishers in many races and field events, so while Oberlin boys competed in a lot of things, if they weren't among the top finishers, no placing was assigned.

This is only the second time this year that Oberlin has fielded a team.

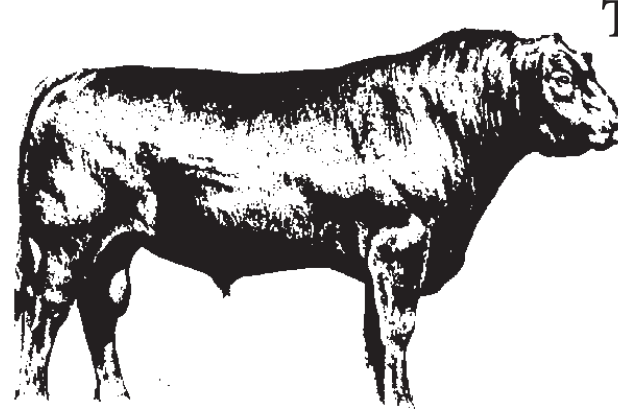
