## Boys track team finishes seventh at Invitational

The Decatur Community High boys team finished seventh at the Annual Oberlin Invitational last Tuesday.

The scoring was close for the top teams. The Norton Bluejays won the meet with 81 points followed by Phillipsburg 77.5, St. Francis 72, Goodland 66, Oakley 64, Smith Center 62.5, Oberlin 57, Atwood 45, Weskan 17, and Wheatland 15.

Hoxie, which took 10th in the women's division, did not play in the boy's division.

Oberlin took first in the 3,200-meter and the 4x800-meter relay races

and second in the 4x400-meter relay.

All Decatur Community High scoring came on running events except for a fifth in the shot put.
