RESOLUTION NO. 648

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO REPAIR, ALTER, EXTEND, RECONSTRUCT, ENLARGE OR IMPROVE THE WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS; TO ISSUE WATER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE COSTS THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SAID INTENTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Kansas (the "City") is authorized under the laws of the State of Kansas to issue general obligation bonds to repair, alter, extend, reconstruct, enlarge or improve the Water System (the "System") owned and operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City hereby finds and determines it to be necessary to repair, alter, extend, reconstruct, enlarge or improve the System, and that all or a portion of the costs thereof should be financed by the issuance of utility revenue bonds of the City, under authority of K.S.A. 10-1201 et seq., as amended and supplemented (the "Act"), with the balance of said costs, if any, to be paid as hereinafter set forth.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF CITY OF OBERLIN, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It is hereby deemed and declared to be necessary to repair, alter, extend, reconstruct, enlarge or improve the System, including, but not limited to, acquisition, construction, installation and equipping of a water treatment facility and related appurtenances, studies and engineering expenses (the "Project") at an estimated acquisition and construction cost of \$6,000,000.

SECTION 2. The Project will not cause duplication of any existing water utility service furnished by a private utility in the boundaries of the City.

SECTION 3. It is necessary to issue Water System Revenue Bonds of the City, in one or more series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$6,000,000 (the "Revenue Bonds"), under authority of the Act, to pay all or a portion of the costs of the Project and related financing costs. The balance of the costs of the Project, if any, will be paid from available System funds. Said Revenue Bonds may be issued to reimburse expenditures made on

or after the date which is 60 days before the date of this Resolution, pursuant to Treasury Regulation 1.150-2.

SECTION 4. Before issuing the Revenue Bonds, this Resolution shall be published one (1) time in the official newspaper of the City, as notice of the intention of the governing body to undertake the Project and to issue the Revenue Bonds; and if within fifteen (15) days after the publication of this Resolution, there shall be filed with the Clerk, a written protest against the Project or the issuance of the Revenue Bonds, signed by not less than twenty per cent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City, the governing body shall thereupon submit such proposed Project and the proposed Revenue Bonds to the electors of the City at a special election to be called for that purpose as provided by the Act. If no sufficient protest is filed with the Clerk within the period of time hereinbefore stated, then the governing body of the City shall proceed to authorize the Project and to issue the Revenue Bonds.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be effective from and after its adoption by the governing body.
