The Fredrickson Insurance team won the Little League Baseball Tournament while The Bank won the regular-season league championship in Decatur County summer recreation play.

In Little League tournament last Tuesday, The Bank beat Ron's Applying 17-5 and Fredrickson overcame Ward Drug 18-6 in the preliminary games.

Then Fredrickson beat The Bank 13-11 to take the tournament.

The Bank took the league championship, winning five games and losing only one during the regular season. Fredrickson was second with a 4-2 record. Ward was 3-3 and Ron's 0-6.
