The Decatur Community High girls came in first and the boys third at the Rawlins County Invitational track meet last Tuesday.

The Oberlin girls scored 177 points, followed by Rawlins County 130, Dundy County (Benkelman, Neb.) 91, Hitchcock County (Trenton, Neb.) 66, Goodland 43 and the Colby junior varsity 33.

The Dundy County boys won with 172 points, followed by Goodland 148, Oberlin 113, Hitchcock County 59, Rawlins County 38 and Colby 2.

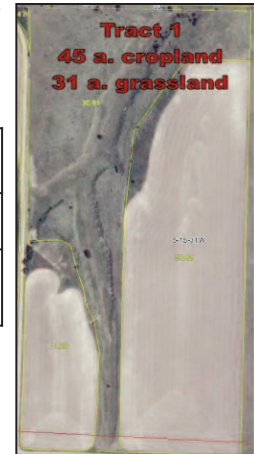
