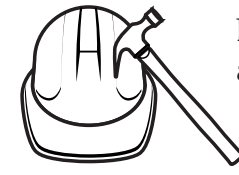

## Junior varsity boys win track meet

The Decatur Community High underclassmen won the Rawlins County Junior Varsity Track Meet last Monday, while the Oberlin girls came in fifth.

The boys scored 162 points, followed by Goodland 136, Colby 91, Oakley 61, Cheylin 30 and Atwood 12.

The Colby girls won their side of the meet with 127 points, followed by Atwood 120, Cheylin 70, Goodland 45, Oberlin 42.5 and Dund County, Neb., 30.5

Ganon Henningson, Grant Gilliam, Rex Diederich and Kennedy Fortin all took individual firsts while the 4x100-meter and 4x800-meter relay teams also took first for the boys.

The tournament took place April 21 at Decatur Community High School, directed by Terry Ream.

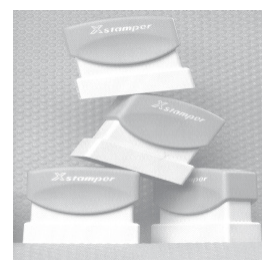
Four Oberlin teams came in first or second in their divisions. Winning the tournament were:
