

Program allows county to use U.S. cash

The three steel bridges that the county plans to build will be paid for entirely by federal money, at no cost to the county.

Reece Construction of Scandia is doing the project, Road Supervisor Tim Stallman said at the Tuesday, Aug. 28, commissioners' meeting, and has started on the first of three bridges in the southwest corner of the county, about eight miles west and 8 1/2 south of town. They will move to work on the other two in

two and three-week intervals. The locations are three miles west and five south and 13 miles south and one west of Oberlin. If all goes well, he said, they should be done by the end of October.

Mr. Stallman said that he is able to do this, thanks to a program called the Federal Funds Exchange. Before the program, any money that the state received for its counties had to be used for state-sanctioned projects, done according to federal

regulations and oversight.

But with the exchange program, he said, the county is able to exchange that federal allowance for state money, which lifts the regulations and strings attached to federal programs.

"It used to be that we had to use the money for projects under their (federal) regulations," said Mr. Stallman, "but it ends up taking a lot longer to finish a project; it can take a year just to plan it when you

do it that way. And it ends up being more expensive. But this way, we can leave the federal money in the hands of the state, where it can do more for them, and we can take the state money to do bigger projects here, and I can make that money go farther."

Mr. Stallman said he will be able to complete the three steel bridges because he saved the money he was given last year. With this year's money, he said, it should work.
