Red Devils basketball takes tough post-win loss

The Decatur Community High boys basketball team lost a road game to the Wallace County Wildcats 89-58 on Friday in Sharon Springs.

The game was a downer for the Red Devils, which had just come off a 3-1 run in the Northwest Kansas League Tournament, beating Quinter, Oakley and Greeley County before losing a close match to the tough Hoxie Indians in the championship.

On Friday, the Wildcats took charge and led in every quarter, outscoring Oberlin 26-17, 26-21, 22-10 and 15-10.

Noah Nelson led the Red Devils in scoring, hitting 60 percent of his field-goal attempts including five of six three-point shots and all four of his free throws. He had 21 points, Kyle Breth had 12, including a pair of three pointers, Tyler Bruggeman 9, Ganon Henningsen 8 including two of two from three-point range, Kelden Breth and Ryan May 3 each on three-point shots, and Konnor Fortin 2.

Henningsen was perfect, hitting all his field goals, from both three and two-point range.

The team had 10 assists. Bruggeman led the way with four, followed by Kyle Breth 3 and Kelden Breth, May and Regent Erickson, 1 each.

Bruggeman also led in rebounds with 10, followed by Kyle Breth and Nelson, 3 each, and Keagen Blau, Konnor Fortin, May, Henningsen, Andrew Wade and Kennedy Fortin, 1 each.

Henningsen blocked 2 shots and

Murray had four assists; Hissong, three; and Dorshorst, two.

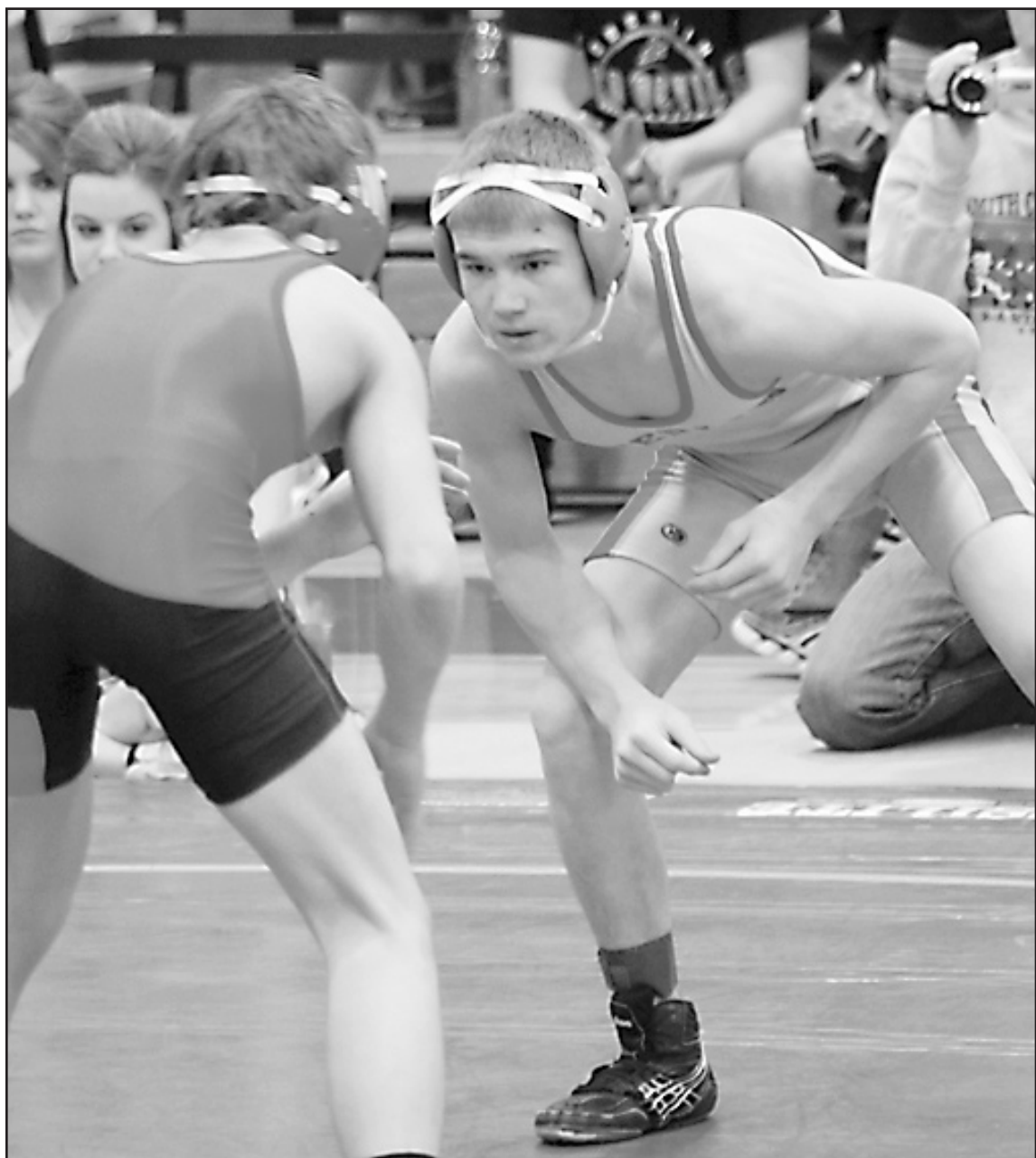

College gets grant

The Dane G. Hansen Foundation has awarded the Northwest Kansas Technical College at Goodland a \$50,000 grant for the "Tools for Success" project.

The project pays for the purchase of three tool kits for each of the programs in the Transportation and Construction divisions. These tool kits expand access to high-wage, high-demand careers by making rental tool kits available to students.

Kansas students may use the tools to attain technical education credits and industry-recognized credentials before graduation through a tuition waiver program. Otherwise, access is limited for students who can't afford to buy the necessary tools, ranging from \$400 to \$3,300 per program.

The rental kits are available for Automotive Technology, Collision Repair, Diesel Technology, Carpentry, Electrical Technology, Engineering Technology, Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning, and Welding.
